<b>Information &amp; Sources</b>	Identifies more than 3 types of relevant information and more than 3 categories of sources of that information.	Identifies 3 types of relevant information and 3 categories of sources of that information.	Identifies 2 types of relevant information and 2 categories of sources of that information.	Identifies less than 2 types of relevant information or less than 2 categories of sources of that information.
<b>Balance</b>	Includes potential arguments and facts on both sides of the policy question that are fleshed out.	Includes potential arguments and facts on both sides of the policy question, but one side is significantly more fleshed out.	Only includes potential arguments and facts on one side of the policy question.	Includes very few potential arguments and facts.
<b>Organization</b>	Concepts are logically arranged; connections between concepts are clearly shown; and structure of the concepts is readily apparent.	Almost all concepts are logically arranged; connections between concepts are shown; and there is some structure to the concepts.	Most concepts are logically arranged and connections between some concepts are shown, but others appear to be missing.	Concepts are generally not logically arranged and connections between concepts are not shown.
<b>Labeling</b>	All concepts and connections are clearly labeled and cross-linkages are also shown.	Almost all concepts and connections are clearly labeled and some cross-linkages are also shown.	Most concepts and connections are labeled.	Most concepts and connections are not labeled.
